## Call for application: Funding of events for the subject-specific qualification of doctoral students

The KSBF Graduate Center invites applications for funding of events for the subject-specific qualification of doctoral students.

A wide variety of event formats can be proposed for funding: Workshops and Workshop Series, Summer/Winter/... Schools, Coffee Talks, Guest Lectures...

Funding can be requested for lecture honoraria for guest lecturers/workshop leaders from outside the HU as well as their travel expenses. Booking of rooms and catering during the event are explicitly not eligible for funding, the same concerns travel expenses of participants.

Those eligible to apply are supervisors of doctoral students at KSBF, doctoral student initiatives, and institutes (in each case also in cooperation). Subject clusters should be formed in order to reach a diverse group of participants; at the same time, the offers should be sufficiently specific to stand out from the general continuing education market and existing workshops of the Humboldt Graduate School. Doctoral students in all phases of the doctorate (as well as those interested in doctoral studies in the advanced stages of deciding to pursue a doctorate at KSBF) are eligible to be addressed.

Funds must be spent by December 2023. It is anticipated that there will be followup calls on a semi-annual schedule.

Please submit your application using the prepared form **by 15/12/2022**. Decisions on all applications received should be finalized by mid-January 2023.
