Dr. Sofia Pazzagli (HU Berlin) A career path as a woman in applied quantum optics



What exactly does a postdoc do at a research institute or university? What scientific questions does he or she want to address? What is their daily work routine? At our regular Lab Tours, female postdocs of the various institutes on the Adlershof Campus introduce us to their workplace and talk about their personal career path – how they got to where they are now and how they imagine their professional future.

This time, Sofia Pazzagli, a scientist from the Physics Department of HU, will give an overview of her research topics and tell us about her career path from Italy to Germany.

Sofia Pazzagli started at HU as a postdoctoral researcher in 2019 after first postdoc positions in Florence and Vienna. She gained her PhD from the University of Florence in 2017. Her research area focuses on setting up and developing a new laboratory for single-molecule microscopy and spectroscopy and for the characterization of photonic platforms designed to control the single-molecule emission.

The lab tour is aimed at female PhD students, postdocs and master's students and will be held in English.
