Acquisition of third-party-funding

The workshop aims to prepare the participants for the independent acquisition of third-party funding. First of all, the workshop provides the participants with an overview of the most important (national and European) funding agencies and schemes in regard to their current career stage. It also explores strategies how to find a fitting funding program. The participants are also taught the basics of application design by addressing the following questions, among others: Which parts does a proposal consists of? Who reads the proposal? How do I establish a connection between my project and the funding program? Common review procedures and evaluation criteria will be presented, and insights into formal and informal aspects of the review process will be provided. Success factors and strategies in the application process will be presented and the handling of rejected applications will be discussed.

About the trainer

Dr. Neela Enke holds a doctorate in Biology and has over 10 years experience as a researcher and leader in several European research institutions. She is also a coach for PhD students, Postdocs, university employees and teams. As a trainer she offers workshops on career development in Science as well as diversity and conflict management. She is also a trained mediator with a focus on conflicts in research organisations (<http://www.scienza-berlin.de/>).
