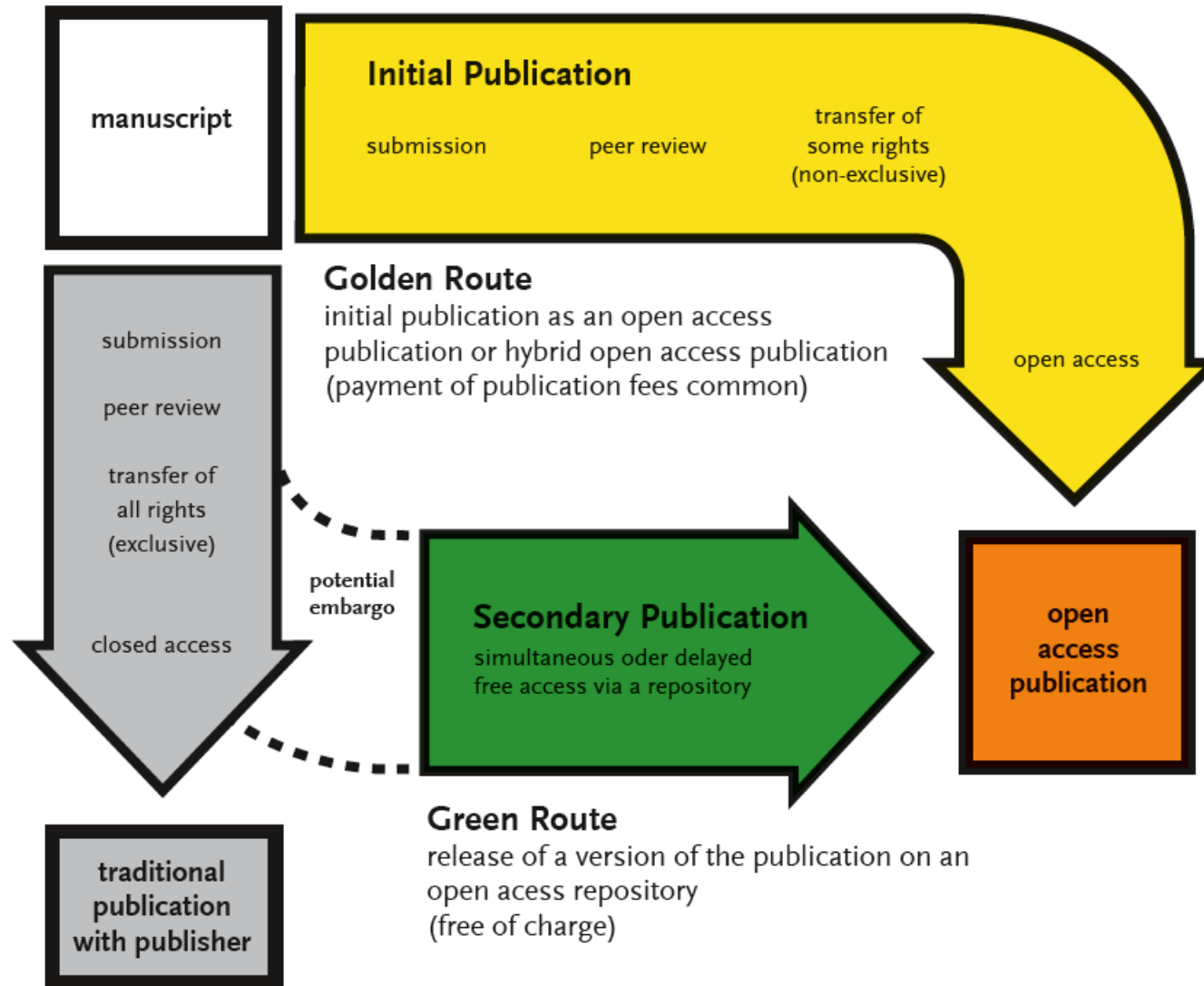

Gold and Green Open Access



Gold Open Access (or: Gold road of OA)

- immediate free access to an initial publication
- e. g. journals: publishing in a full OA journal or in a so called hybrid journal (hybrid OA)
- → gold standard of OA, main issue: funding

Green Open Access (or: Green road of OA)

- publishing a version of an already published publication which is not yet freely accessible
- e. g. journals: depositing usually a manuscript version in a publicly available repository
- → compatible with closed access, main issue: rights

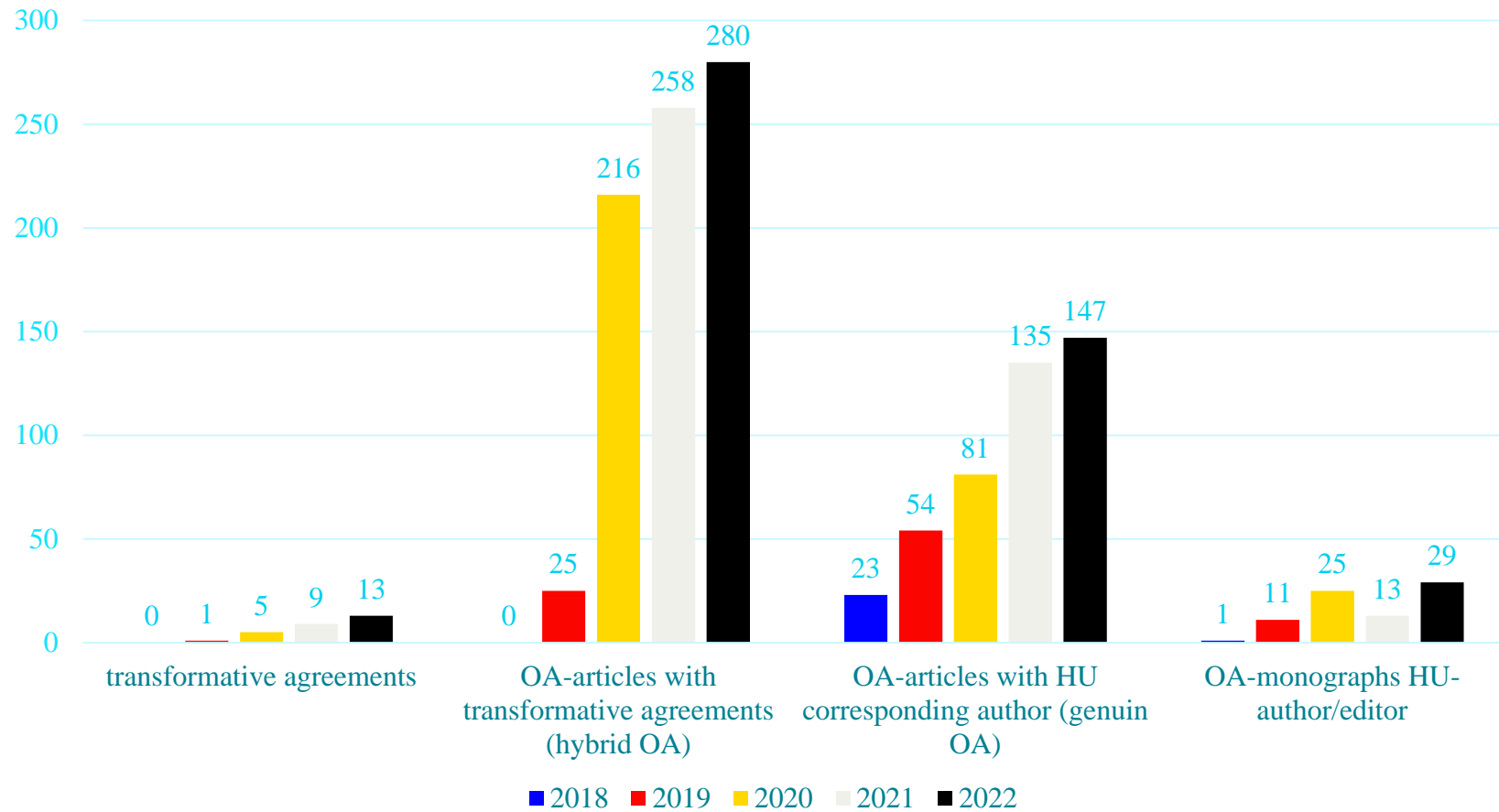


Benefits of Open Access Publishing

- publishing strategy: „gold or green? And how!?“
- research is free to read for everyone
- public research funding → public results
- better visibility and research results easier to find
- citation advantages
- ensuring easy use and reuse, incl. text and data mining
- retention of author's rights
- long-term availability (if archived properly)



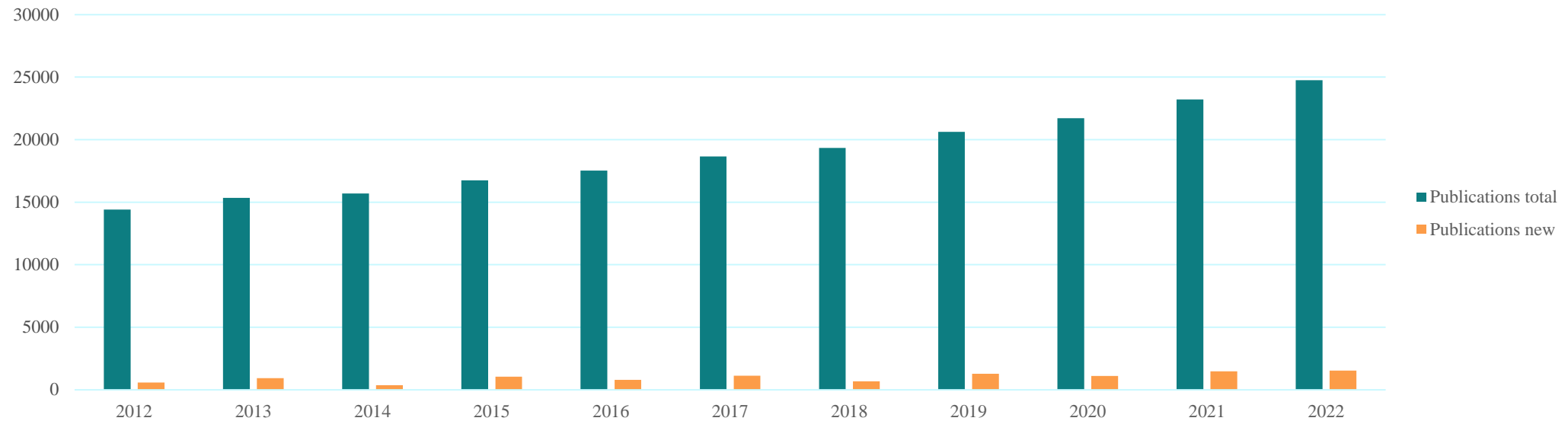
- All members of Humboldt-Universität may use it to publish their research works
