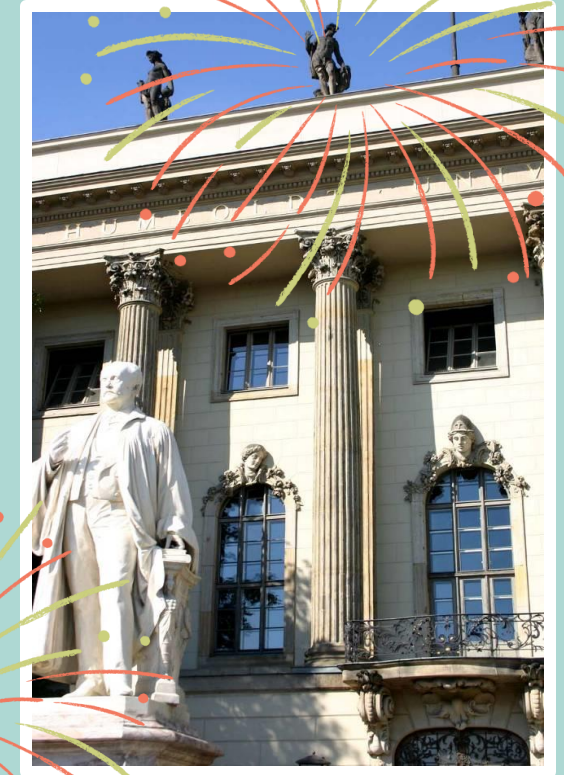

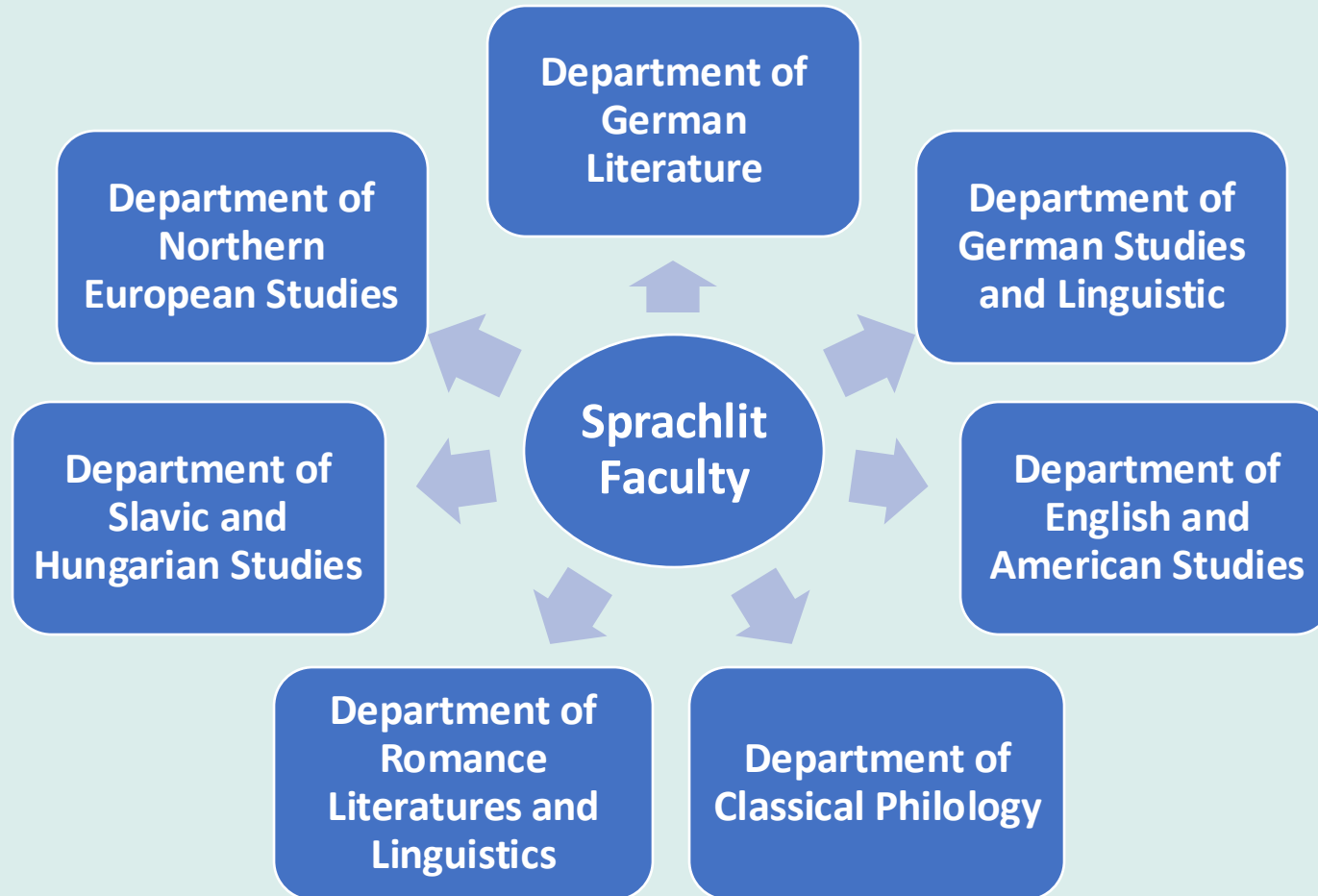

Courses of Study

Bachelor's students (undergraduate)

- can be **matriculated in up to two B.A. courses of study.**
- Please note: there are **several different German B.A. courses of study** (focusing for example either on literature or on linguistics), thus, please **make sure that you choose the correct one(s).**
 - German – German Literature – German Linguistics

Master's students (graduate)

- can **only be matriculated in one M.A. course of study.**
- **Please note that as a B.A. student you cannot take M.A. classes and vice versa.**

Module Structure

- Each **course of study consists of different modules**, which structure the course content thematically and chronologically.
- All modules that you need to take in a course of study are listed in study and examination regulations. (for degree students)
- A module **consists of several components and concludes with a final module examination.**
 - **Course types:** Lecture, Seminar, Tutorial, Exercise
 - **Exam types:** Written/Oral Exam, Take-Home-Exam, Term Paper/Essay

Module Structure

- To **complete a module** all **components** must have been **attended/completed** and a **final module examination (MAP)** must have been **passed**
- Each module and all associated courses and examinations are **allocated a certain number of credit points/ECTS**.
- **Final Module examination = Modulabschlussprüfung (MAP)**
 - exam is usually only taken in one or two courses of the module
 - **Exam grade applies to all components/courses of the module**
 - Grades are given in decimal numbers: 1,0 (excellent) - 4,0 (sufficient) = Pass; 5,0 = Fail

Module Structure

- For **exchange students at SprachLit Faculty** we **created Study Guides**
→ they **list all modules you can take**, including **which courses/components each module consists of**, the **ECTS per course/exam** and the **type of exam** for the module
 - [Study Guides on our website](#)
- **The topics of the courses may vary** from semester to semester.
 - There are usually several seminars to choose from, from which 1-2 are then selected.
 - Please refer to the **course catalogue (AGNES)** to find out which courses of a module are offered in specific semesters. But always keep Study Guides in mind!

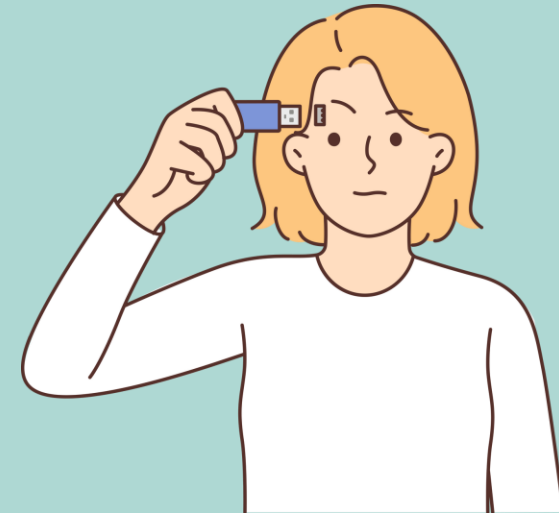

 - HU Berlin has no requirements on how many classes/ECTS you need
 - If you **only need ECTS** but no exams/grades: **you can choose single classes**
 - If you need **ECTS and exams/grades**: choose **whole modules** following study regulation/Study Guide



Please also note ...

- **No teaching and practical classes**
 - Incoming Students **cannot** take classes/modules from the teaching program/didactics (Lehramt)
 - Incoming Students **cannot** take classes from the Praxismodul/Praktikum
- **EACH MODULE CAN ONLY BE TAKEN ONCE!**
- **No individual arrangements**
 - Incoming Students **cannot** make any individual arrangements with instructors. Everything must be confirmed by us.

Classes from your course of study

- **Regular modules / single classes**
 - They are from the course(s) of study you are enrolled in
 - You find an overview of possible modules /classes for your course of study in our [Study Guides](#)
 - Study guides are available for most courses of study at SprachLit faculty. For some subjects without guides, the study and examination regulations must be used.
 - You can **choose whole modules** → you get **ECTS + exam/grade**
 - Or you **choose single classes** → if you don't need exam/grades, **you will just receive ECTS** for completed classes
 - You register for classes via [AGNES](#) (after receiving HU Account)



Classes from your course of study

- **Special Modules / Zusatzmodule**

Courses from üWP

- **What are üWP Courses?**

- überfachlicher **W**ahlpflichtbereich = üWP = Interdisciplinary compulsory elective area
- Courses for the **acquisition of interdisciplinary skills**, such as gender competences and intercultural competences, and the acquisition of key qualifications.
- the courses / modules cannot be from the course(s) of study you are enrolled in
- **You can take üWP classes from other courses of study at SprachLit faculty, other faculties or central institutions.**
- **max. 2** courses / modules per semester
- only ECTS, **no** exams/grades possible!
- üWP classes can be found in the [course catalogue \(AGNES\)](#)
→ **Only classes listed there count as üWP classes!**

Important remarks

Please note that you are **only** allowed to choose from these modules above and not from any other modules that you might find on AGNES or online.

If the table shows the name of a specific class (e.g. "American Cultural History"), you must choose this class on AGNES. If it says "Choose one lecture/seminar" etc. then you can freely choose from the list on AGNES.

- On the first page there is always **general information about which courses you can choose from.**
- You will also find **direct links to the course catalogue** for the current semester.
- Please note that only the Study Guides for English/American Studies are in English. All others are in German.

This course will explore contemporary U.S. American graphic memoirs, exploring how comics serve as a powerful medium for autobiographical storytelling. Together, we will discuss how artists narrate personal and intimate experiences through the interplay of image and text. We'll study how image and text work together to visualize trauma, self-representation, memory, and resilience—and learn what makes the comic medium such an affective space for narrating stories of illness, displacement, queerness, race, and coming of age.

Our exploration will focus on both the form and content of these works, analyzing how issues of gender, class, and race are portrayed within these narratives and how they engage with broader U.S. American cultural, social, and political contexts. Readings will include a diverse range of voices and styles, from graphic memoirs like Art Spiegelman's *Maus* and Alison Bechdel's *Fun Home*, to more recent works by George Takei, Cece Bell, Nora Krug, and Kindra Neely.

As part of the course, students will have the opportunity to create their own short graphic memoirs, using accessible tools such as *Making Comics* by Lynda Barry, Canva, or StoryboardThat. This activity is planned to invite students to experiment with visual storytelling and reflect on their own experiences—no artistic background or drawing skills required.

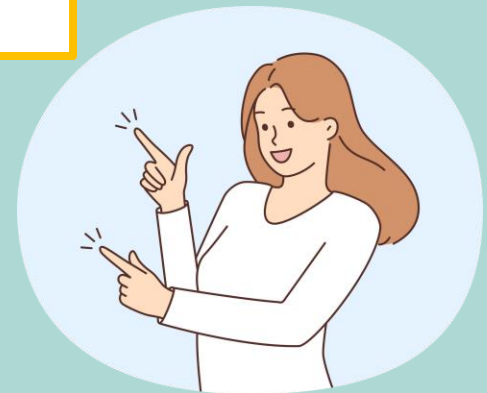
