Class Selection and Preliminary SprachLit CC



Overview of Steps

- = if you need exams + grades
- Check **Guide** of the course(s) of study you are matriculated in
- 2. Search for the module in the course catalogue on AGNES
- 3. Put module and ist components on your preliminary SprachLit CC

1. Check Guide

Open the guides (see slide 9) for both courses of study to see the following:

- Module components
- ECTS/exam info
- In which semester the module is offered
- Special modules are also directly in guides.
 - → PLEASE NOTE: In Summer Semester only the special module "Einführung in die Literaturwissenschaft" is taught.

2. Course catalogue on AGNES

- Find the modules in the <u>course catalogue on AGNES</u> (in the guides the course catalogue is also linked to help you find everything)
- Choose the classes from the list that you need (usually you do not need to choose every class listed under a module on AGNES)
- Click on the class to find more information (content, where and when it takes place etc.)

IT IS YOUR OWN RESPONSIBILITY THAT YOUR CLASSES DO NOT OVERLAP!

3. Preliminary SprachLit CC

- Save the <u>SprachLit CC template</u> and open it on your computer
- Fill out the first page with your personal information
- Click the correct semester
- Fill out one table per module (please put all the information required: module number and title, class codes and titles, ECTS, exam type)

If you only need ECTS

- 1. Check guide to see which modules are open to Incoming students in which semester
- 2. Find these modules in the course catalogue and choose freely from them (you do **not** need to follow the module structure as shown in the guides)
- 3. Put "Einzelkurse/Single classes" as module title on your Preliminary SprachLit CC and list all of your single classes (you do not need to divide them per module). Select "no exam."

PLEASE NOTE THAT YOU CANNOT CHOOSE SINGLE CLASSES FROM MODULES THAT ARE NOT LISTED IN THE GUIDE AS THEY ARE NOT OPEN TO INCOMING STUDENTS!

IMPORTANT: PLEASE NOTE

- Make sure that you are matriculated in the right course(s) of study
- →German literature and linguistics are not taught together but are separate courses of study!
- →B.A. Deutsch and B.A. Deutsche Literatur are quite similar do not mix up their module structures!
- Check which modules are available in which semester
- ONLY choose modules shown in the guide no matter what else you find on AGNES or in study regulations. The guide is what counts for Incoming students.

IMPORTANT: PLEASE NOTE

- On the first page of the guide you can see if you can take "Deutsch im Mehrsprachigkeitskontext" single classes
 as part of the course of study. There is no extra table as you cannot complete modules with exams/grades but only take
 single classes from modules 1 and 2 for ECTS. Please note that only a limited number of Incoming students can join and
 must be approved by the instructors
- Modules marked yellow in guide: pay attention to what is written since these are a bit tricky!
- Tutorials are voluntary. Incoming students cannot receive ECTS for them!
- Check the rules for B.A. Germanistische Linguistik on the first page of the guide
- Some classes in M.A. Linguistik are taught in English
- NO INDIVIDUAL AGREEMENTS WITH INSTRUCTORS! EVERYTHING HAS TO BE APPROVED BY US!
