Ca' Foscari University of Venice is a public university that was established in **1868** as **the first International Business School in Italy.**

Our name comes from our main administrative building, a Gothic palace built in the 15th century by one of our city's great noble families – the Foscari – on the Grand Canal in the heart of Venice, Italy.





ECONOMICS & MANAGEMENT / HUMANITIES COURSES: FOUR TERMS

Term 1: mid Sept – mid Oct, exams at end of October

Term 2: Nov – early Dec, exams mid December

Term 3: Feb – mid March, exams end of March

Term 4: April – early May, exams mid-end of May

Exams (summer session): late August – early September

LANGUAGES & CULTURES COURSES: TWO SEMESTERS

Semester 1: early Sept – late Dec, exams from early Jan through early Feb

Semester 2: early Feb – late May, exams from early June through early July

Exams (summer session): late Aug – early Sept

Documents that you need to prepare for your application

- □ transcript of records (certificate prepared by the home university);
- learning Agreement: thanks to the <u>Erasmus Without</u> paper it is advised to fill out the Online Learning Agreement (OLA) through the <u>dashboard platform</u>;
- ☐ English or Italian certificate (B2 level) check the "Recognized certification" tab; native English speakers do not have to submit any language certificate;
- □ copy of a valid **ID or passport.**




Cultural activities




TURNING DEGREES INTO CAREERS




HOUSING OFFICE

The Housing Office offers:

- professional assistance with finding the right accommodation
- support in the signing of a fair and clear rental agreement
- for non-EU students: provision of a letter attesting the rental agreement for use in the visa request process

If the service is successful in finding you suitable lodgings, there is **a 175 euro fee**.





SANTA MARTA RESIDENCE "CAMPLUS"

- Completed in 2019
- 650 beds in single and double rooms
- Prices range from 228 euros/month for a double room for regional scholarship holders to 530 euros/month for a superior single room; these prices are representative of our newer residences
- The complex is characterized by green space and common rooms








NEW! – ECONOMICS CAMPUS RESIDENCE


