

**=IMPORTANT= Hygiene rules for in-person examinations =IMPORTANT=
during the summer semester 2021 at the MNF**

- As a candidate in a written or oral in-person examination during the summer semester 2021 **you agree to adhere to** the following rules stipulated by the HU. **You will be asked to confirm this with your signature at the examination.**
- **You must cover mouth and nose with a medical mask (FFP2) at all times on the university premises and in the examination rooms.**
- Persons experiencing symptoms of respiratory disease or fever are not allowed into the university buildings and will be escorted off the premises immediately should they not comply. If you suddenly start to experience symptoms of Covid-19 while on the premises, please leave immediately. We ask you urgently not to begin an examination if there is even the slightest suspicion of illness and not to put anyone else at risk.
- **Negative test result (<24h) or a proof of vaccination** must be presented to participate in an exam.
- There will be **identity checks** before entering the examination rooms.
- **Wash your hands or use hand sanitizer** before entering examination rooms.
- Keep a **minimum distance of 1.5 m** to the next person!
- When walking in hallways and corridors keep to the right hand side, similar to road traffic, and use available floor markings to guide you.
- Do not linger in entrances, hallways and lavatories for longer than absolutely necessary.
- Within the examination rooms, **available seats are marked for use**. Do not use any other seats. Follow the directions of the staff at all times. Non-compliance can lead to exclusion from the examination.
- **At the end of the examination**, the staff will organise the submission of papers and the vacation of the room. Please **leave the building immediately and follow available floor markings**.
- Attendance lists for all rooms will be kept for four weeks in the Dean's Office at the MNF and subsequently destroyed.
