2.	. In the case of a fast-track doctoral project, the project has been described in more detail in an exposé on (date) and has been accepted by the supervisor and doctoral committee of the Faculty of Arts on (date). ²	
3.	The duration for the doctoral project is agreed from: (semester, year) to (semester, year). If there are good reasons (for example, family responsibilities, health restrictions), the duration of the doctoral project can be extended.	
4.	For the doctoral project, the agreed work / time plan by the doctoral candidate and the first supervisor listed in the appendix applies, as of (date).	
5.	The agreement with its attachments shall be reviewed (frequency, e.g. annually) by the involved parties and modified if necessary.	
6.	Both supervisors undertake to ensure that the period between the submission of the dissertation and the defense does not exceed months (frequency, e.g. six months).	

Supervision of the dissertation project

- 7. The doctoral candidate and both supervisors discuss the progress of the work on the basis of the exposé, interim reports and individual chapters (frequency: first supervisor at least once per semester, second supervisor at least once a year). The doctoral candidate will create a short report on the meetings, which will be signed by the first supervisor.
- 8. The first supervisor undertakes to regularly check the preparation of these interim results and the planned progress of the work and to comment on the delivered contributions comprehensively verbally and / or in writing on the agreed meeting dates.
- 9. In addition to the mentoring talks, the doctoral candidate will give an annual colloquium presentation on the status of the work and will receive feedback on the status and improvement possibilities of the dissertation project.

¹ Changes or adjustments to this supervision agreement must not be contrary to the "spirit" of the doctoral degree regulations.

 $^{^2}$ If a cumulative dissertation pursuant to §7(3) of the doctoral degree regulations is planned, this would have to be included here.



10. Both supervisors support the doctoral candidate in his / her publications. In particular, the two supervisors will do their utmost to ensure that publications by the doctoral candidate can be placed in reputable journals under specific required and justified authorship.

Accompanying training program

- 11. Between the parties, the obligatory attendance of professional events as well as interdisciplinary qualification events by the doctoral candidate will be agreed upon. Scope and content will be defined in the work plan.
- 12. In the course of the doctoral project, the doctoral candidate will undertake scholarly work (e.g. participation in a conference, submission of a journal article, organization of a conference, internship or performance of a course, stays abroad, etc.). These will be recorded in the work schedule in a timely manner.

Behavior in case of conflict

- 13. In case of conflict, the parties first turn to the relevant Examination Board or the Doctoral Committee of the Faculty. In the case of a dissolution of the supervision relationship, the relevant Examination Board will endeavor to find an alternative appropriate supervision relationship.
- 14. The doctoral candidate and both supervisors undertake to comply with the rules of good scientific practice, as set out in the "Statute of the Humboldt-Universität zu Berlin for the Securing of Good Scientific Practice and the Handling of Allegations of Scientific Misbehavior," 17 February 2014 ("Satzung der Humboldt-Universität zu Berlin zur Sicherung guter wissenschaftlicher Praxis und über den Umgang mit Vorwürfen wissenschaftlichen Fehlverhaltens"). For the doctoral candidate, this includes consulting with both supervisors or other persons of trust in cases of doubt. For the supervisors, this expressly means the obligation to honor and name copyright regulations for texts or findings of the doctoral candidate.
